

2023 Don Banks Memorial Scholarship

Application deadline: EXTENDED TO September 30, 2023

The URCA Annual Scholarship Award

The Don Banks Memorial Scholarship Program recognizes the scholastic and community achievements of URCA member company employees, their spouses and children.

How much is awarded?

- 1. One \$20,000 scholarship, awarded at \$5,000.00 per year, and must continue to meet the following criteria:
 - A. The recipient must maintain an annual grade point average of 2.0.
 - B. If the recipient is an employee, spouse, child or dependent of the employee, the employee must be actively/gainfully employed by a URCA contractor member and in good standing with local union. Please note: A past applicant who has received a \$20,000 scholarship would not be eligible to receive this scholarship in future years.
- 2. Four one-time \$2,000.00 scholarships, non-renewable and based primarily on financial need.

What is the award to be used for?

Studies on the undergraduate or graduate level at a college or university, including a community college or technical school.

How do you obtain an application?

Applications must be completed and submitted no later than September 30, 2023.

The Union Roofing Contractors Association (URCA) is an organization whose membership is composed of union roofing contractors signed to a collective bargaining agreement with Roofers Local 36 and 220, and participating in programs providing training, health & welfare coverage and pension funds for their employees and their families. URCA has established a scholarship program to provide financial support toward the continuing education of URCA family members. One annual scholarship of \$20,000, awarded at \$5,000.00 per year, will be awarded for studies at an accredited college, university or technical school. Renewal is based upon the maintenance of an annual grade point average of a 2.0 or above. In addition, four one-time annual scholarships of \$2,000 each will be awarded non-renewable and based primarily on financial need. for studies at an accredited college, university or technical school. These scholarships are awarded primarily on the basis of financial need. All URCA scholarships are available to employees of URCA member companies, their spouses or children.

OBJECTIVE—To develop qualified professionals through education and to award those who have the desire to continue to improve their quality of life.

ELIGIBILITY—All candidates must be:

- 1. High school, undergraduate or graduate college/university or technical school students.
- 2. Provisionally accepted as a student into undergraduate or graduate degree programs for the coming academic year by an accredited college or university. Or, provisionally accepted as a student into an accredited technical/vocational school.
- 3. Immediate family members of a full time employee of a URCA member contractor. Immediate family is defined as self (employee), spouse, child or dependent.
- 4. Please note: A past applicant who has received a \$20,000 scholarship awarded at \$5,000.00 per year, would not be eligible to receive this scholarship in future years.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS—The following data is required from each candidate:

- 1. The official application form. Copies of the application will not be accepted.
- 2. The official transcripts of all high school, college/university and technical school records.
- 3. The completed evaluation sheets, one of which is to be submitted directly from a faculty member or school counselor from the institution where the student is currently enrolled. The second evaluation must be filled out by an adult not related to the student.
- 4. A letter indicating provisional acceptance from the college/university or technical school where the continuing education will be undertaken.
- 5. A current picture, to be used for publicity purposes only.



AWARDS

- 1. One annual \$20,000 scholarship awarded at \$5,000.00 per year, will be awarded and renewable for up to another three years upon the maintenance of an annual grade point average of "C" (or equivalent). Please note: A past applicant who has received a \$20,000.00 three year renewable scholarship would not be eligible to receive this scholarship in future years.
- 2. Four one-time annual \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded, based primarily on financial need. One third of each award will be paid directly to the student and two thirds will be paid directly to the purser of college/university or technical school where the recipient will do his or her continuing education studies.
- 3. For purposes of allocation, the funds are to be used for the following: tuition, books, room and board, or other school-related expenses.

JUDGING

- 1. The URCA Scholarship Committee has the sole authority of granting the scholarship awards. Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic performance, extra curricular activities, employment experience, faculty recommendations and financial need.
- 2. These scholarships will be awarded without consideration of race, creed, national origin or gender.
- 3. All applications shall become the property of Union Roofing Contractors Association.
- 4. All selections are considered final.
